Louisiana Expands Healthcare Support for the Uninsured, Disabled, or Aging (January 2006). The Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, Bureau of Health Financing has awarded a contract to Affiliated Computer Services (ACS) to expand Louisiana's personal care services system for the uninsured, disabled, and aging. Call center representatives will enter data collected in phone interviews and in-home evaluations into a home-care data system, and this data will generate reports to help determine eligibility and develop health plans.
