The Ohio State Health Department purchased a new mobile warehouse management system that helps them distribute vaccines and other important medicines throughout the state in a matter of hours. The system, designed to help Ohio respond to an outbreak or biological attack, also allows officials to graphically track health information from Ohio's eight regions using automatically maintained records.
